# DISASTER ASSISTANCE

**If you recently sustained loss or damage due to severe storms, flooding, landslides and mudslides, you may be eligible for disaster aid**

**To register, call:  
1-800-621-FEMA (3362)**

When you register for disaster assistance please have the following available:

- Private insurance information, if available
- Address and zip code of the damaged property
- Directions to the damaged home or property
- Telephone number where FEMA can reach you
- Social Security Number

*FEMA is unable to complete a registration if neither the applicant, their spouse, nor a minor child in the household — who is a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national or qualified alien — has a Social Security number. At least one of these individuals must have a Social Security number for the household to receive assistance. A Social Security number is required for identity verification purposes and to prevent a duplication of benefits.*
